<b>NV Morgan's Bay Sparkling Cuvee Brut</b>	<i>South Australia</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Pale gold in color with fruity aroma, the palate brings forward a luscious strawberry sweetness		
<b>NV Taylor Ferguson Sparkling Prosecco</b>	<i>King Valley Vic</i>	<b>\$45.00</b>
Pale straw in colour aromas of lemon and a hint of strawberry and precede slightly toasty/yeasty characters. Distinctively creamy the opulent, lemon sherbet like, crisp palate fills the mouth.		
<b>NV Domaine Chandon Brut</b>	<i>Yarra Valley Vic</i>	<b>\$60.00</b>
Bright green-straw, tangy chardonnay prevailing over the softer pinot, some brioche/nougat notes, long, clean finish. Like all domaine sparkling wines, is a methode traditionnelle.		

## Chardonnay

<b>NV Morgan's Bay Chardonnay</b>	<i>Mildura Vic</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Lightly oaked chardonnay delivers white peach and green melon fruit with a cleansing citrus kick on the finish.		
<b>2017 Cape Vine Reserve Chardonnay (reserve)</b>	<i>Margaret River WA</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Intense aromas of white peach, orange blossom and sauteed lemon. Richly flavoured yet light and refreshing. Mix of vibrant fruit characters with linear acidity that drives the flavour and makes the wine finish beautifully dry.		
<b>2016 Dragonfly Chardonnay</b>	<i>Geographie WA</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Barrel-fermented in used French oak and the fruit flavours are, in any event, intense, with grapefruit and mineral to the fore; the finish is long.		
<b>2016 Rhythm &amp; Rhyme Chardonnay</b>	<i>Southern SA</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Attractive pale-medium straw colour with green hues. Aromas of ripe stone fruit, melon and peach abound. The palate has good weight, peach and melon flavours dominating with a hint of citrus, and a clean, delicate finish.		

## Sauvignon Blanc

Pale straw color with attractive green hues. A distinctive tropical and herbaceous palate of typically well ripened sauvignon blanc		
<b>2021 821 South Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc</b>	<i>Marlborough NZ</i>	<b>\$45.00</b>
Delivers aromatic grapefruit and punchy capsicum aromas and flavours with lush fruit and balanced crisp acidity.		

## Something Sweet

<b>2018 Angove Chalk Hill Blue Moscato</b>	<i>South Aus</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Crystal clear with pale green hues. Crisp and fresh bursting with grapey flavours that flow seamlessly onto the palate with crisp tropical fruit and a clean finish.		
<b>2011 Elderton Botrytis Semillon (375ml)</b>	<i>Barossa Valley SA</i>	<b>\$45.00</b>
Glowing green-gold masses of juicy cumquat and mandarin flavours.		

## Other

<b>2017 Tahbilk Riesling</b>	<i>Tahbilk VIC</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Shows great length and depth with intense citrus, lime and passionfruit with background hints of guava and refreshing natural acidity.		
<b>2016 Domain Chandon Pinot Noir Rose</b>	<i>Yarra Valley Vic</i>	<b>\$45.00</b>
Vibrant with delightful aromas of strawberry, cranberry, musk & cinnamon spice. Bright fruit characters are complimented by a soft texture & dry finish. Best enjoyed young and fresh.		
<b>2018 Les Peyrautins Grenache Rose</b>	<i>Languedoc, FRANCE</i>	<b>\$45.00</b>
Light salmon colour. Subtle aromas of fresh red fruit such as raspberry, strawberry, plum, redcurrant with some grapefruit. Dry, medium(+) acidity, medium alcohol, light body, medium flavours intensity of elegant and fresh red fruit, such as strawberry, raspberry, redcurrant, grapefruit		
<b>2019 Paladino Pinot Grigio</b>	<i>Italy</i>	<b>\$45.00</b>
Bright, light pink, the bouquet has strawberry and spice, the palate is long, crisp and fresh, with a juicy but dry finish.		
<b>2018 Tucks 'NOW' Pinot Gris</b>	<i>Mornington Peninsula</i>	<b>\$50.00</b>
Lovely silky texture with aromas of poached pear, peach and spice		

## Shiraz & Blends

<b>NV Morgans Bay Shiraz Cabernet</b>	<i>Mildura Vic</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Notes of spice and plum, hints of cassis with lingering soft tannins providing excellent structure.		
<b>2016 Cape Vine Reserve Shiraz</b>	<i>Margaret River WA</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Robust and spicy with a slightly sweet finish. You will also enjoy a velvety and slightly syrupy mouthfeel when enjoying this varietal.		
<b>2018 Sanguine Estate Progeny Heathcote Shiraz</b>	<i>Heathcote Vic</i>	<b>\$50.00</b>
Deep red with some purple hues. Enticing varietal fruit driven aromas of spicy cherry and plum with some herbal notes. On the palate cherry and plum fruits, some spice and a hint of oak with good length		
<b>2018 Angove Family Crest Shiraz</b>	<i>McLaren Vale SA</i>	<b>\$40.00</b>
Rich, ripe smells of dark berries and cherries, a touch of Christmas cake, and a good lick of coffee and dark chocolate from the oak. The palate is surprisingly medium-bodied, but there is still bucket-loads of black fruits, some chewy but approachable tannins, and a good kick of mocha on the finish.		

## Cabernet Sauvignon & Blends

<b>NV Anchorage Cabernet Merlot</b>	<i>South Aus</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Up-front dark berry flavour and cassis. Fleshy merlot fills the mid-palate, subtle oak influence to finish.		
<b>2018 Shaddow Cape Cabernet Sauvignon</b>	<i>Margaret River WA</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
Intense aromas of blackcurrants, plums and black cherries with a toasted chocolate eucalyptus background. Violets add freshness to the rich complexity and the palate is full of rich dark fruits filling your mouth with flavour.		
<b>2012 Flametree S.R.S Wilyabrup Cabernet Sauvignon</b>	<i>Margaret River WA</i>	<b>\$65.00</b>
The immediate and striking strength of the wine is its extreme length and purity, a siren allure that may lead many to drink it long before it reaches its plateau of ultimate perfection; high quality grapes have been handled with admirable sensitivity by winemaker Cliff Royle.		
<b>2018 Angove Family Crest Cabernet Sauvignon</b>	<i>McLaren Vale SA</i>	<b>\$40.00</b>
Deep red/purple colour. The bouquet is ripe and attractively varietal, with classic violet, blueberry, mulberry and cassis aromas, and these flavours re-appear throughout the palate. It's intense and powerful, rich and bright, with freshness, poise and real persistence.		

## Pinot Noir & Other

<b>2021 Panorama Mornington Peninsula Pinot Noir</b>	<i>Mornington Peninsula</i>	<b>\$50.00</b>
Intense varietal characters of berry & forest floor, round palate balanced with fine, almost creamy tannin finish		
<b>2014 Domaine Chandon Yarra Valley Pinot Noir</b>	<i>Yarra Valley Vic</i>	<b>\$50.00</b>
An elegant wine distinguished by a rich structure of firm, silky tannins.		
<b>2012 Dog Point Pinot Noir</b>	<i>Marlborough NZ</i>	<b>\$70.00</b>
Very deep red/purple hue. The bouquet is impressive and loaded with rich, ripe, black cherry fruit, the palate likewise rich and concentrated, full-bodied and sweetly-fruited, but it's all balanced by good tannins and excellent structure. A glorious wine, very Burgundy-like.		
<b>2014 Cape Vine Merlot</b>	<i>Margaret River WA</i>	<b>\$35.00</b>
It boasts earthy notes and develops distinctive berry notes as it ripens, along with licorice and chocolate flavors.		
<b>2013 Blue Pyreness Merlot</b>	<i>Pyreness VIC</i>	<b>\$40.00</b>
Fragrant savoury red fruit mix on the bouquet, varietal cassis and black olive interwoven in the fine tannin and oak structure.		
<b>2012 Leconfield Merlot</b>	<i>Coonaworra, SA</i>	<b>\$45.00</b>
Rich merlot with great depth of flavour & structure, in which oak plays an important, but not prominent role in the structure.
